The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The short prayer by the petitioner Reetinder Singh attorney of Shri Vikas Garg in this invocation by way of petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking directions for expeditious disposal of applications filed under Order 6 Rule 17 CPC and Order 1 Rule 10 CPC read with Section 151 for amendment of the plaint and also under Section 4 CPC for

consolidation of Civil Suits being of the same very nature and cause of action which as per the claim of the petitioner are pending before the Court of learned Civil Judge, Junior Division, Ludhiana.
