The present petition has been filed with a prayer that an appropriate direction be issued to respondents No.2 to 4 to decide the complaint dated 15.07.2021 (Annexure P/11) submitted by the petitioner-Institution to respondent No.4 for taking action against respondent No.5, who according to the petitioner-Institution, is not only harassing the institution, but also defaming the institution.

On being asked as to what legal provisions have been violated by respondent No.5 so as to invite criminal proceedings against him, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.5 is in habit of filing frivolous complaints with the police authorities against the petitioner-Institution and officers of the petitioner-Institution are being called by the police officials every time, when such a complaint is filed by the respondent

No.5, which is causing harassment to the petitioner-Institution and to its employees.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions to submit that in case henceforth, any complaint is filed by respondent No.5 against the petitioner-Institution with the police authorities, the same will be examined at first instance by them and in case, assistance of any officer of the petitioner-Institution is necessary, the procedure as envisaged under the Cr.P.C will be followed so as to avoid any harassment to the petitioner-Institution as being alleged by them.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the undertaking given by the learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioner-Institution in the present petition survives and the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
