1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

At the outset, learned counsel states that the petitioners have submitted representations Annexure P/2 and P/3 dated 06.09.2017, 20.01.2020 as well as 23.05.2021, 03.12.2018 and 05.02.2020 but no decision has been taken in respect thereto till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the aforementioned representations, in accordance with law, in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion to respondent No.2 only.
4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana accepts notice and after perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.
5. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for

instant petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representations Annexure P/2 and P/3, in accordance with law within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order while keeping in mind the observations of Hon'ble the Supreme Court in **C. Jacob vs. Director of Geology and Mining and another, 2008 (10) SCC 115.**
