The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 275 dated 02.09.2016, registered under Sections 186, 307, 333, 353, 120-B, 34 of the IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted the concession of regular bail by this Court, vide order dated 10.12.2019 passed in **CRM-M-37575-2019** (Annexure P-3) and was regularly attending the court proceedings, vide zimini orders passed by the trial Court (Annexure P-4), however, on 29.11.2021, he could not appear before the trial Court on account of noting down a wrong date and his bail/surety bonds have been cancelled and non-bailable warrants have been issued against him.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court and face the trial.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position,

however, it is submitted that PW ESI Dharamvir was present on the date when the petitioner absented from the Court proceedings and, therefore, the absence of the petitioner was not *bona fide*.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the appearance of the petitioner before the trial Court will facilitate the early conclusion of trial, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to appear before the trial Court within a period of 15 days from today and on doing so, the trial Court will release him on bail, subject to his furnishing fresh bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Till the time the petitioner appears before the trial Court, his arrest shall remain stayed.

However, this will be subject to a condition that petitioner will deposit a cost of Rs. 10,000/- with the District Legal Services Authority, Sirsa.
