Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. challenging order dated 31.10.2019, Annexure P-6, whereby petitioner has been declared Proclaimed Offender in cross case bearing GD No.35 dated 02.07.2018 under Sections 323, 341, 365, 511, 354 and 149 of IPC, 1860, Annexure P-3, in FIR No.133 dated 02.07.2018 under Sections 323, 427, 149 of IPC and Sections 3 (1) (ii), 3 (1) (iv) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar Rural, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition has become infructuous as the FIR as well as the cross-case have been quashed on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the parties.
