[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 26.10.2021 in CRWP No.10160 of 2021 in case titled as Kulwinder Singh @ Sonu vs. State of Punjab and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.10.2021 reveals that CRWP No.10160 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide the representation filed by the petitioner within three weeks by passing a speaking order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the respondents have rejected the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation filed by the petitioner vide order dated 10.05.2022, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 10.05.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner, as prayed for.
