For the reasons mentioned in the application, same is allowed and accompanied Annexures P-2 and P-3 are taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CRM-M-7902 of 2022

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. by the petitioner seeking regular bail in FIR No. 13 dated 21.01.2022, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the matter has been compromised between the petitioner and the complainant and as per the compromise an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- has already been paid by the petitioner. It is further submitted that petitioner was arrested on 30.01.2022 and now is not required by the police.

The bail application is opposed by State counsel, who submitted that the case is at initial stage and as such no ground is made out to grant bail to the petitioner.

However, Mr. Lalit Singla, Advocate who has appeared on behalf of the complainant has pleaded no objection if the bail is granted to the petitioner.

From the above, it transpired that matter has been compromised by the petitioner with the complainant. Further, co-accused Sukhpreet Kaur and Anish have already been granted interim anticipatory bail by this Court. In these circumstances, no purpose is going to be served by keeping the petitioner in custody for any longer period. Without commenting on the merits of the case, instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released to regular bail during trial on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned.
