The present application has been filed for impleading the applicants as respondents No.16 to 40. The prayer of the petitioners in the main petition is that rather than appointing them on regular basis, the petitioners are being allowed to continue as Guest Faculty Lecturers, which is contrary to the rules.

In the present case, the petitioners are seeking continuance of

their services and no relief is being sought against the applicants. In case, the applicants have any grievance for not filling up the posts on regular post, they can avail their appropriate remedy rather than being impleaded in the present petition.

The applicants are not the necessary parties to be impleaded in the present petition keeping in view the relief sought for and the application is accordingly disposed of.

**CWP-3708-2019 along with
other connected petitions**

By this common order, above mentioned seven writ petitions are being disposed of as all the above mentioned writ petitions involve same question of law.

The grievance of the petitioners in the present petitions is that they should be adjusted as Extension Lecturer/Assistant Professor keeping in view the qualification, which they possess coupled with the Rules and Instructions issued by the respondent-Government of Haryana on the said aspect.

Learned State counsel submits that during the pendency of the present petitions, keeping in view the order passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 11.02.2019 and 20.02.2019, the respondents have considered the claim of the petitioners as per the instructions issued by the respondent-State of Haryana and petitioners have already been adjusted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the only apprehension of the petitioners is that as they were appointed in terms of the interim orders passed by this Court, they might be relieved from the service.

Learned State counsel submits that respondent-State has already

issued instructions with regard to the readjustment of the Extension Lecturers and the same will be complied with in the case of the petitioners also and once the petitioners are adjusted, they will be allowed to continue in service till work exists or regular lecturers are appointed, whichever is earlier, and prays that in case there is any misconduct on the part of the petitioners, the respondents be given liberty to proceed against them in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petitions and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.

It is made clear that the liberty being prayed by the respondents is available with them.
