Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.39 dated 1.3.2015 registered under Sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the proceedings in the trial Court on the basis of order of interim bail dated 25.2.2022 passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajender Kumar has not refuted the aforesaid fact and further submits that the present petition be disposed of accordingly as the trial is going on.

Alleged recovery has already been effected in this case and the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the trial Court. So, there is no necessity to send the petitioner to police custody at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 25.2.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
