ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.51 dated 17.02.2020 under Sections 392, 342, 148, 149 IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms act (Sections 395, 379-B, 450, 120-B, 201, 212, 216 IPC and Section 27, 25.1B(F) of Arms Act, 1959 added later on) registered at Division No.6, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

A Co-ordinate Bench of this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner on 26.07.2021 on the ground that other co-accused had been released on bail and also the custody of the petitioner is for more than one year. Furthermore, there is no allegation that in the interregnum, the petitioner had tampered with the evidence or hampered the investigation.

Given above, the present petition is allowed and interim order dated 26.07.2021 is made absolute subject to the compliance of following condition:-

- i) **the petitioner shall surrender all weapons, firearms, ammunition, if any, along with the arms license to the concerned authority within 30 days from the date of release and inform the Investigator about the compliance. However, subject to the Indian Arms Act, 1959, the petitioner shall be entitled to renew and take it back in case of acquittal in this case.**

All pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
