[1] Prayer in the petition under Sections 10 &12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-2) dated 07.09.2021 in CWP No.17450 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-2) reveals that CWP No.17450 of 2021 was disposed of vide order dated 07.09.2021 by directing the respondent to decide representation filed by the petitioner after hearing the petitioner as well as respondent No.7 in the said writ petition in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within 01 month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondent to do the needful.

[4] Learned DAG on the other hand has produced copy of order

same is taken on record and copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 22.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 22.03.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
