1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 06.10.2020, in CWP-16342-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-16342-2020, was disposed of vide order dated 06.10.2020, by directing the respondent to decide application dated 04.08.2020 and representation dated 03.09.2020 and 15.09.2020 within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel contends that pursuant to issuance of notice, the respondent has decided the claim of the petitioner as contained in the application/representations and has issued armed license to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.
