Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.262, dated 06.09.2021 under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 13-17, District Panipat.

Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that all prosecution witnesses have already been examined in the case and that the prosecution evidence stands concluded. He states that as per his instructions, the case is now fixed for defence evidence and arguments before the Trial Court.
