This is a petition that has been filed seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned order dated 04.11.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Commission of Inquiry constituted by the Punjab Government to look into the allegations of false FIRs being registered during the last 10 years.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that at the present moment, the case of the petitioner is pending before the Director General of Police, Punjab and, therefore, he would be satisfied in case the petitioner is given an opportunity to appear before the Director General of Police, Punjab and set up his defence.

Learned State counsel would submit that as the matter is already pending before the Director General of Police, Punjab for consideration, the State would have no objection in case the petitioner is given an opportunity to present his case.

The instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to allow the petitioner herein to set up his case before the Director General of Police, Punjab, who will take into consideration all the arguments raised before passing any order.

Consequently, the instant writ petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
