The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks directions for quashing the challan dated 14.02.2022 (Annexure P-19).

It is a conceded position by the counsel that there is an alternative and efficacious remedy available as the 'Dispute Rederessal Mechanism' as provided under Section 20 of the Street Vendors (Protection of Livelihood and Regulation of Street Vending) Act, 2014 is in place, since 14.01.2022.

Accordingly, liberty is granted to approach the said forum, since the petitioner cannot approach the writ Court at the first instance and it is for the forum as such to first look into the issues which are being adjudicated in the present writ petition.

Dismissed as not pressed with the aforesaid liberty.
