Prayer in this petition is for transfer of a petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that there is a distance of about 40 Km between Amritsar and Tarn Taran and the petitioner/wife has already filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C., before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, at Patti, District Tarn Taran and an FIR No.205 dated 29.10.2019 under Sections 406, 498-A, 315, 148, 149 IPC is also registered against the respondent at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the respondent/husband has filed the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, as a counter-blast, which is pending at Amritsar. Lastly, it

is submitted that the petitioner is not in a position to defend the case properly by travelling from Tarn Taran to Amritsar and bear the litigation expenses.

Counsel for the respondent has, however, submitted that the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, already stands dismissed on 18.05.2022, therefore, this petition may be disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
