Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 421 dated 06.10.2018, registered under Sections 193, 195, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC, at Police Station PS City Mandi Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 12.02.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 12.02.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sandeep Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.02.2020 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
