[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-5) dated 18.01.2022 in CRM-M No.2041 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-5) reveals that CRM-M No.2041 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the District Development and Panchayat Officer, Amritsar, to decide the complaint / representation dated 29.12.2021 submitted by the petitioners within 03 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned Asstt. A.G., Punjab, has filed reply and refers to speaking order (Annexure R-1) dated 05.04.2022, deciding the complaint / representation dated 29.12.2021.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the position noted above, the petitioners do not press the instant petition and

may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 05.04.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is *disposed of*, as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
