The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to close down and wind up the rights and interest of respondent No.3 in running the affairs of Red Cross Medical Store in Government T.B. Hospital, Bhatinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he has no instructions from his client and probably they might not be having any subsisting interest in the matter.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition stands dismissed as not pressed at this stage.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition in case any grievance of the petitioner still subsists.
