CWP No. 3904 of 2020

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the pensionary benefits for which he is entitled for, have been withheld and that too without any valid justification despite the fact that he superannuated on 28.02.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that during the pendency of the petition, all the benefits for which petitioner is entitled for, have already been released and the only grievance of the petitioner left to be redressed is the grant of interest on the delayed release of the pensionary

benefits keeping in view the judgment of the Full Bench of this Court in ***A.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab and others***, 1997(3) SCT 468.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case petitioner files any representation raising the said grievance, appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case, after the decision the petitioner is found entitled for interest, the same will also be released to him within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
