AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 11 dated 17.9.2020, under Sections 13(1)(A) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (Sections 7A, 7B and 7C of that Act added later on) (as amended upto date) and Sections 409/120/467/468/471/120-B IPC (though Section 468 is not mentioned in prayer clause of the petition), registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Phase-1, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

This Court vide order dated 24.2.2021, granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions submits that considering the age of the petitioner and the fact that as on date, custody of the petitioner is not required does not oppose the confirmation of the interim order.

As no custodial interrogation is needed, the interim bail granted on 24.2.2021 is made absolute.

In case of change in circumstances, the State would be at liberty for availing remedies in accordance with law.

Disposed of accordingly.
