Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondent No.4 to take action against the privates respondent on the basis of complaint No.CRM-77792-18 dated 03.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) and further directions be issued to respondent No.4 to comply with the orders passed by Ld. Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana vide order dated 05.12.2018 (Annexure P-2).

Pursuant to the order dated 20.02.2020, a status report by way of affidavit of Jarnail Singh, Inspector, SHO, P.S. Division No.8 Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

The relevant extract thereof, read as under:-

*“That in compliance of the said order dated 05.12.2018 the deponent has conducted inquiry and joined both the parties and Halqa Patwari.*

*After conducted inquiry, the deponent has prepared inquiry report on dated 04.04.2020. On same day, inquiry report has been presented before the Ld. Duty Magistrate/JMIC, Ludhiana (Vernacular copy of Report and translated copy attached as Annexure R-1 and vernacular copy of Statement of Halqa Patwari and translated copy is attached as Annexure R-2 The Ld. Magistrate/JMIC has forward this inquiry report to Ld. Illaqa Magistrate, Ludhiana on dated 06.04.2020. The Ld. Illaqa Magistrate has placed the inquiry report on the file and now, this case adjourned for 09.11.2020 for consideration.*

*That the deponent has already conducted inquiry on the complaint dated 03.12.2018 of the petitioner and also complied with the order of dated 05.12.2018 passed by the Ld. Illaqa Magistrate, Ludhiana and presented the inquiry report in the court of Ld. Illaqa Magistrate for further orders.”*

It is evident from the perusal of the aforesaid extract that the prayers made by the petitioner in the instant petition already stands answered and inquiry report has been furnished to the Court of Illaqa Magistrate for appropriate orders by the competent Court.

In view of the above, no further cause of action survives with the petitioner.

The present petition is rendered infructuous with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.
