KARAMJIT SINGH, J.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking quashing of the order dated 02.03.2007 (Annexure P-9) vide which the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender in case FIR No.6 dated 23.01.2001 under Sections 379/411 of IPC, Police Station Narot Jaimal Singh, District Pathankot.

The counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the main accused Ranjit Singh who faced trial was acquitted vide judgment dated 08.10.2007 (Annexure P-2). As per said judgment no offence is made out against the accused persons including the petitioner. He further submitted that the impugned order was not passed in accordance with

the procedure mandated under Section 82 Cr.P.C. He further submitted that petitioner has joined the proceedings before the Trial Court on 16.03.2022 in the light of order of interim bail dated 28.02.2022 passed by this Court. Copy of the order dated 16.03.2022 passed by concerned JMIC is placed on record.

The State counsel has opposed the present petition but at the same time admitted that the petitioner has appeared in the trial Court and released on interim bail by the said Court vide order dated 16.03.2022.

In view of the above, as the petitioner has joined the proceedings before the Trial Court, the impugned order has ceased to exist. Accordingly, the present petition is hereby disposed of and order of interim bail dated 28.02.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute subject to the condition that petitioner should appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing.
