Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia* for quashing the impugned orders dated 30.07.2008 (P-10) and 14.11.2019 (P-25), whereby, services of petitioner were terminated from the post of Computer Faculty.

Perusal of order dated 13.02.2020 reveals that although, copies of petition were supplied to learned State counsel, but there is no formal notice of motion till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking, Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 3, 4, 5, 7 & 8, whereas, Ms. Ankita Malhotra, Advocate, for Mr. Shekhar Verma, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Chamkaur Singh, District Education Officer (Secondary Education), Ferozepur, on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 4 & 5 along with annexures, filed and the same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to the opposite side. Registry to tag the reply at appropriate place.

Parties were heard at length, but taking into consideration the fact that orders dated 12.10.2012 (P-15) & 20.06.2017 (P-21) passed by respondents Nos.2 & 1, respectively, are not under challenge; therefore, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer of petitioner.

Faced with the above situation, learned counsel, on instructions from petitioner, wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file fresh with better particulars, including challenging the orders dated 12.10.2012 & 20.06.2017 as well.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
