AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The grievance raised in this petition is that the complaints made by the petitioner were not being considered by the police officials.

Learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer that complaint dated 24.9.2020 Annexure P-6 be decided.

Brief facts are that for the incident that occurred on 13.6.2020 FIR was registered at the instance of Harjit Singh (respondent No.5). The petitioner gave his cross version of the incident which was not considered.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh submits that the complaint (Annexure P-6) would be considered expeditiously in accordance with law, not later than four months from today.

In view of the statement made by learned State Counsel, the petition is disposed of without commenting on the merits of the case.

Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance, if any.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any, is rendered infructuous.
