The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to for submitting the status report in the complaint made by petitioner against respondents No.5 to 10 dated 16.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) and register FIR against them.

Notice.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. An appropriate number of copies of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Given the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued to the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied in case directions may be issued to respondent No.3 only to decide the complaint made by the petitioner dated 16.12.2021(Annexure P-1) within time bound manner.

The prayer is not opposed.

Given above, the present petition is disposed of by issuing direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad (Haryana) to decide the complaint dated 16.12.2021 (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed.
