Certain land owned by persons known as Ruko and Shero was allegedly illegally mutated in favour of persons who were not actually the successors of the said persons. In fact, the said persons were alive and living in Pakistan. After getting the mutation, the land was sold to third parties. It has been alleged that the department came to know about the illegal mutation and directed initiation of proceedings for reversal of the same. It was also resolved that the sale deed would be challenged in the Civil Court. However, nothing has in fact been done. Even representation dated 01.02.2022 (Annexure P-9) has not elicited any response.
