An appropriate number of copies of the paperbook be supplied to him during the course of the day. Given the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued to the private respondents.

In case, the grievance of the petitioner still exists, he shall be at liberty to avail legal remedy in accordance with law including approaching this Court.

Petition is allowed to the extent mentioned above. All pending applications, if any, stand disposed.
