The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5.

The case of the petitioner is that she was initially married to respondent No.5-Ajju S/o Jume Khan who gave her divorce by Triple Talaq and is now married to one Shahid. The grievance of the petitioner is that respondent No.5 continuously threatens the petitioner.

At this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take necessary action, if so required in accordance with law.

Keeping in view the limited prayer sought for and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.3 to look into the grievance of the

petitioner and decide the representation dated 14.02.2022 (P-3) in accordance with law.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
