In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the election of the office bearers of the Board of Directors of the respondent-bank are not being held, which is causing prejudice to them.

After notice of motion, the respondents have appeared and it has been brought to notice of this Court that the agenda has already been issued for conducting the meeting for election of the office bearers of Board of Directors for 20.04.2022 and the appropriate meeting will be held on the said date and, therefore, the grievance of the petitioner does not survive further.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is likelihood of mischief by respondents as on an earlier occasion also, the meeting was adjourned without any reasonable cause and therefore, the

proceedings of the meeting may kindly be video-graphed so as to ensure free and fair holding of the said meeting.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioners pay for the expenses of video-graphing the said meeting, the same will be arranged by the bank-authorities and the meeting dated 20.04.2022, which has been summoned for electing the office bearers of the Board of Directors of the respondents-bank vide agenda dated 02.04.2022, will be video-graphed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners accepts the said proposal and submits that whatsoever the cost for video-graphing of the meeting will be presented to the petitioners, the same will be paid by them to the respondents-bank/authorities within a period of seven days of presenting the said bill.

Keeping in view the above, let the recording of the meeting dated 20.04.2022 be video-graphed at the cost of the petitioners.

Keeping in view the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and the same be disposed of as such.
