The petitioners herein seek the quashing of the FIR bearing No.239 dated 01.12.2021 registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, under Section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957.

Mr. Karanbir Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1-State in this case in pursuance of the copy of the instant petition having been sent to this respondent in advance, apprises the Court that the investigation in connection with the subject FIR is still continuing.
