Vide this application, advancement of the date of hearing in the accompanying petition is sought, which otherwise stands adjourned to 05.05.2022.

Though the next date of hearing is obviously very near, yet learned counsel submits that the prayer in the accompanying petition itself is to the effect that the petitioners' representation dated 16.11.2021 (copy Annexure P-8) be decided.

However, it is seen that in the prayer clause of the petition, he is also seeking an interim relief qua "respondents no.3 to 11" with there actually being only four respondents in the petition itself.

It is further to be noticed that learned counsel appearing for the respondent PSIEC (respondents no.2 and 3) points out that respondent no.4 (Pawan Preet Kaur) has filed CWP no.15651 of 2021 impleading the petitioner as a respondent therein and with the petitioner also having put in an appearance upon notice issued in that case, which fact has also not been disclosed in this petition.

In view of the above, the application is allowed and the date of

hearing in the accompanying petition is advanced to today and taken up today itself.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh one if he so chooses with better particulars and with any such petition filed to be listed, if at all it is to be heard on merits, with the aforesaid petition (CWP no.15651 of 2021).
