HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of a cross case being G.D. No.42 dated 06.05.2017 registered under Sections 420, 406, 182 IPC in FIR No.97 dated 06.05.2017 (wherein Section 379-B IPC has been deleted) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise effected between the parties.

At the outset, learned State counsel points out that the petitioner had misled the police by getting a false FIR registered about snatching of gold ornaments from him which were later on recovered from his possession and a DDR No. 42 dated 06.05.2017 for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 182 IPC was registered against him.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
