By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of interim bail under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C. on account of the non-bailable warrants issued against him for his absence from the trial court in case FIR No.55, dated 24.06.2013, registered at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 353,332,186,382,427,148 and 149 IPC.

Upon this court pointing out that the petitioner being a proclaimed offender he would not be entitled to interim bail, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press this petition but submits that upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial court and being arrested, if he files any petition under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., that be decided within a specified time.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with no comment made on the merits of the case but if the petitioner upon being arrested files any petition under the

provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., that will be considered and decided by the trial court expeditiously.
