The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the Regional Transport Authority, Faridkot, is not deciding claim of the petitioner with regard to the grant of permits on the routes as advertised by the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even though the petitioner has already given a legal notice to respondent No.2 for deciding his claim with regard to the grant of permit in question expeditiously but he has not received any communication with regard to the said claim, and therefore, the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a direction is given to the Regional Transport Authority, Faridkot, to decide the legal notice dated 18.12.2021 (Annexure P-5) by passing appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Navdeep Chhabra, DAG, Punjab, who has joined the

proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the advance service of copy of the petition, accepts notice on behalf of the State and, on instructions from the worthy Principal Secretary of the Department concerned, raises no grievance with regard to deciding of the legal notice dated 18.12.2021 (Annexure P-5) by the Regional Transport Authority, Faridkot, in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the above and without going into merits of the case or the claim being raised in the present petition or the legal notice dated 18.12.2021 (Annexure P-5), respondent No.2 is directed to dispose of the said legal notice dated 18.12.2021 by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of this order.
