The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 215 dated 26.08.2021 under Sections 379-B, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 411 and 473 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, the complainant has not been examined as yet.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at this stage, with liberty to file a fresh petition for regular bail after the complainant in the present case is examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage, with the aforesaid liberty.

It is made clear that the second petition for regular bail, if any filed by the petitioner, would be considered independently on its merit in accordance with law.
