The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 10.07.2000 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3- District Magistrate, Faridkot, District Faridkot, under the Sub-Rule 2 of Rule 200 of Punjab Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 and the said order was to remain operative for a period of three years unless revoked previously, as well as the order dated 18.04.2001 (Annexure P-5) Passed by respondent No.2- Commissioner, Faridkot Division, Faridkot whereby the appeal preferred by the petitioner had been dismissed.

The aforesaid order dated 10.07.2000 (Annexure P-3) was to remain operative for a period of three years. The said period of three years has already come to an end. It seems that the petitioner has no subsisting grievance or interest in pursuing the present petition as of now. Even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
