This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.315 dated 27.12.2017 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.5, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

A perusal of the paper book shows that in the present case, an application for discharge dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-6) had been filed by the present petitioner to which it has been stated that even reply has been filed on 21.12.2021 and the matter is stated to be pending for 17.03.2022.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits

that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the present petition is disposed of with direction to the trial Court to decide the said application for discharge, while considering the order framing charges, as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six weeks from today.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the trial Court to decide the said application for discharge filed by the present petitioner dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-6) as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.

It would be open to the petitioner to raise all the points which have been raised in the present petition at the time of arguing the said application for discharge.
