AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

1. This petition was filed for seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner from respondents No.4 and 5. Further directions were sought that FIR be registered against respondents No.5 to 8 under Sections 354/354-A/354-B/501-B/506/509/34/499/295-A/120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860.
2. Learned State counsel had filed reply dated 3rd May, 2021.
3. In paragraph No. 4 of the reply, the answering respondent i.e. Deputy Superintendent of Police, Nangal, District Ropar pleaded that complainant had earlier withdrawn the compliant but if she gets her statement recorded for the revival of the complaint, appropriate action would be taken after thorough inquiry.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions submits that till date complainant had not got recorded her statement with regard to revival of the complaint.

5. In view of the above facts, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of.

6. However, in case petitioner gets her statement recorded within four weeks from today, the Deputy Superintendent of Police concerned in consonance with the pleadings in the reply will expeditiously consider the complaint and take an appropriate action in accordance with law.
