The prayer in this present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of directions to official respondents No.1 to 4 for conducting a fair and impartial inquiry in complaints including legal notice dated 31.05.2018 (Annexure P-3 Colly) and further for the issuance of directions to the official respondents to take legal action against those persons, who has defamed the petitioner while uploading the false status of the FIR No.249 dated 22.09.2014 registered under Sections 420, 406, 494, 120-B IPC, 1860 (Annexure P-1) at Police Station City Kapurthala.

The learned State counsel submits that every FIR, which has been registered has to be uploaded to the website of Sanjh Kender as per the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India w.e.f. 15.11.2016 vide order dated 07.09.2016 passed in Writ Petition (CRL) No.68 of 2016 titled as Youth Bar Association of India Versus Union of India and others.

As per para 2 of the preliminary submissions of the State reply, the FIR has now been quashed by this Court as the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In this view of the matter, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
