Instant petition had been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for setting aside the judgment dated 01.10.2021 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, SBS Nagar, vide which the petitioner was convicted in a case bearing FIR No.0091 dated 12.11.2017 under Sections 323 and 325 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Mukandpur, District SBS Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising out of this FIR on the basis of compromise dated 10.12.2021.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the present petition has become infructuous inasmuch as the petitioner has been acquitted in the appeal on the strength of compromise entered into between the parties.

Learned counsel for the respondents have also not disputed the said fact.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed for having been rendered as infructuous.
