1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 05.11.2019, in CWP-31910-2019.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that representation dated 29.10.2019, filed by the petitioner has been rejected vide order dated 28.07.2020, and that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order Annexure R/1 dated 28.07.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
