The prayer made by the petitioner in the instant writ petition is for issuance of necessary directions to officials respondents No. 2 and 3 to look into the grievance raised by the petitioner in his representation dated 07.01.2022(Annexure P-2) and for taking appropriate action against private respondents No.4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was married to the daughter of respondent No.4. On account of matrimonial discord, respondent No.4 along with his sons i.e. Respondents No.5 and 6 accompanied with private respondents No.7 and 8 opened the attack on the petitioner and his family members. Despite having reported the matter to the police and other authorities vide complaint dated 07.01.2022 (Annexure P-2), no action has been taken thereupon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. C.L. Pawar, Senior DAG Punjab, who has put in

appearance on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 on service of advance

copy of petition, has accepted the notice. He submits that representation, Annexure P-2 will be looked into by respondent No.2.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and decide the same in accordance with law, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copies of this order and representation dated (Annexure P-2)

Instant writ petition stands disposed of with abovesaid observations and directions.
