This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuing direction to respondents no.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents no.5 to 11 as the petitioners are living in live-in-relationship.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chamkaur Singh, has submitted that petitioner no.1, who is wife of respondent no.5, had earlier claimed that she was living with petitioner no.2 and now has come back to respondent no.5 and thus, has no threat perception and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Nobody has appeared on behalf of petitioners to rebut the same.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
