This is petitioner's second attempt to get bail pending trial in a criminal case arising out of FIR No.178 dated 22.05.2018 registered under Section 393, 302, 323, 34 IPC at Police Station Shanewal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel representing the State of Punjab has pointed out that trial of the case is at its fag end as the prosecution has already examined 14 witnesses out of total 16 witnesses.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, learned trial court is requested to make sincere endeavours for concluding the proceedings pending before it within a period of two months. At this stage, it would not be appropriate to consider the request of the petitioner for grant of regular bail.
