Reply filed on behalf of the State is ordered to be taken on record.

Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to the State to constitute a Special Investigation Team (for short – SIT) to investigate FIR No.37 dated 17.02.2017 registered under Sections 34, 406, 498-A IPC at Police Station City Mandi Dabawali, District Sirsa.

In the affidavit dated 30.04.2021 filed on behalf of the State, it has been submitted that after constitution of a SIT the aforesaid FIR was investigated and since after such investigation no sufficient evidence was found for proceeding against the accused mentioned therein, the State has filed a report before the concerned Court seeking cancellation of the said FIR.

In addition to the afore fact, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on the filing of the cancellation report by the State, the complainant had filed a protest petition before the competent Court which has been rejected resulting in the acceptance of the cancellation report filed by the State and that against such order of the Trial Court, the complainant has filed a revision petition before the Sessions Court at Sirsa which remains pending.

In the light of the afore developments, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
