Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner attained the age of superannuation on 30.06.2020 and retired but the retiral benefits of the petitioner have not been released to him so far by the respondents despite the fact that there is no impediment in the release of the same. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that apart from the said benefit, even the 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP have also not been released to the petitioner in the Cadre of Sub Divisional Engineer, which benefit also needs to be released by the respondents forthwith.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant

Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and Mr. Sunil Kumar Dhanda, Advocate for Mr. Deepak Manchanda, Advocate appears on behalf of respondents No. 2 and 3.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as the petitioner has not been able to submit the required documents, his complete benefits could not be released even though, the provident fund amount has already been released to the petitioner. Learned counsel submits that the moment the petitioner submit the required documents, the appropriate order will be passed releasing his pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner will approach the respondents and will submit the required documents within a period of two weeks.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that as and when all the formalities are completed by the petitioner within a period of next four weeks, the appropriate benefit for which the petitioner is found entitled for, will also be released to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further at this stage keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel.
