Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a directions to the official respondents No. 2 to 7 that the investigation of the case bearing FIR No. 345 dated 27.09.2021 registered under Sections 120-B, 147, 149, 341 and 379-B IPC, Police Station Adampur, District Hisar, may be conducted in a fair and proper manner without any influence from the hands of private respondents No. 8 and 9.

Upon notice, status report dated 17.11.2022 by way of affidavit of Sh. Abhimanyu Lohan, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Detective), Hisar, on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 7, has been filed.

As per the reply, the investigation in the present case has been conducted by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hisar-2. After completion of investigation, no clue of unknown culprits was found and untraced report was prepared by the police on 06.03.2022, which is under process.

In view of the above, no further action is required to be taken in the instant petition and the same stands disposed of, accordingly.
