The petitioner is a defendant in a pending suit for grant of a decree of possession by way of specific performance of the agreement to sell. The aforesaid suit is pending for the last 5 years.

For the first time, the case was fixed on 10.12.2019. Before the start of the Covid-19 pandemic, the petitioner availed as many as 5 opportunities to lead the evidence.

After the pandemic slowed down, the petitioner has been granted more than 15 opportunities to lead his evidence. The petitioner has chosen not to appear, although, he was granted repeated opportunities by the court.

In such circumstance, no ground to interfere in the exercise of supervisory jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, is made out.

Dismissed.
