The instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents as they have performed marriage and also not to interfere in their peaceful life.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has failed to make out any case of threat to the newly wedded couple i.e. petitioners. A perusal of file reveals that the representation (Annexure P-5) has been moved by the petitioner to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur regarding threat perception on the same day when they have solemnized the marriage i.e. 23rd February, 2022. There is no overt act mentioned on the part of the parents of the petitioners in the afore-said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has also failed to make out a case with regard to threat perception after 23rd February, 2022.

At this stage, no case, for providing any protection to the petitioners, is made out.

In view of the afore-said facts and circumstances, the present petition stands dismissed.
